NOTICE OF COMPETITIVE EXAMINATION FOR FIRE CHIEF

A written examination will be given in approximately ninety (90) days, on a competitive basis to approved applicants for the purpose of placing names on the competitive employment list for the class of Fire Chief in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Fire and Police Civil Service Law and the rules of West Baton Rouge F.P.D. No. 1 Civil Service Board.

Application forms may be obtained from Deanna Fourroux at the Port Allen Fire Department located at 700 N. Alexander Ave., Port Allen from 8am -5pm Monday through Thursday or <http://ose.louisiana.gov> and under Testing and Employment.

Completed applications and the required attachments must be submitted in person between the hours of 8:00am -5:00pm Monday through Thursday or by mail (PO Box 757, Port Allen, La 70767) no later than October 11, 2021. Mailed applications must be received by October 11, 2021. Approved applicants will be notified of the exact date, time and place of the examination at least five (five) days prior to the examination date.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

Unless otherwise specified, all requirements listed below must be met by the filing deadline for application for admission to the test.

Must meet all requirements of the Municipal Fire and Police Civil Service Law, including being a citizen of the United States, and of legal age.

After offer of appointment, but before beginning work in this class, must pass a physical examination, the selection and administration of which shall be authorized by the Appointing Authority, designed to demonstrate good health and physical fitness sufficient to perform the essential duties of the position, with or without accommodation.

Must possess a valid driver's license.

RECOMMENDED BUT NOT REQUIRED

Must have obtained Firefighter I and II according to the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) standards.

Must have obtained Fire Officer I according to the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) standards.

Must have obtained Fire Investigator I according to the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) standards.

MUST MEET ONE OF THE FOLLOWING THREE QUALIFICATIONS

EITHER

Must have a bachelor's degree in fire science, fire administration, business administration, public administration, or a related curriculum. Must have three (3) years of experience in full time fire service

positions, at least one (1) year of which must have been in positions which include administrative or supervisory responsibilities.


OR

Must have an associate degree in fire science, fire administration, or a bachelor's degree in an unrelated curriculum. Must have at least five (5) years in fire service positions, at least one (1) year of which must have been in positions which include administrative or supervisory responsibilities.

OR

Applicant must possess one of the following: high school diploma, general educational development (G.E.D.) certificate, high school transcript, affidavit from the issuing high school, associate's or bachelor's degree, or college transcript, any one of which must indicate that graduation has occurred or a degree awarded. A certification of completion shall not be sufficient to substitute for a diploma or G.E.D. certificate. Must have at least six (6) years of experience in fire service positions, at least three (3) years of which must have been in positions which include administrative or supervisory responsibilities.
